

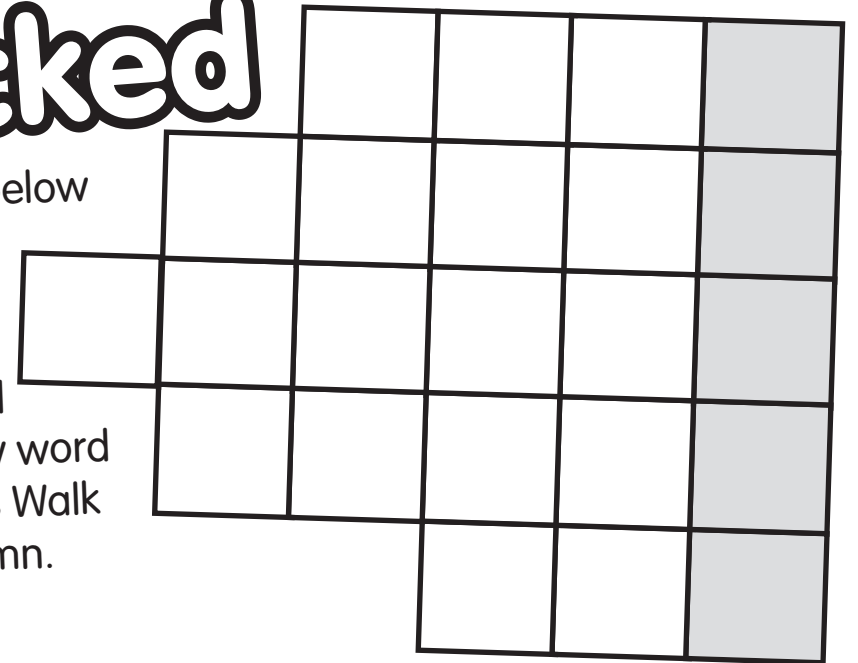
Know the signs

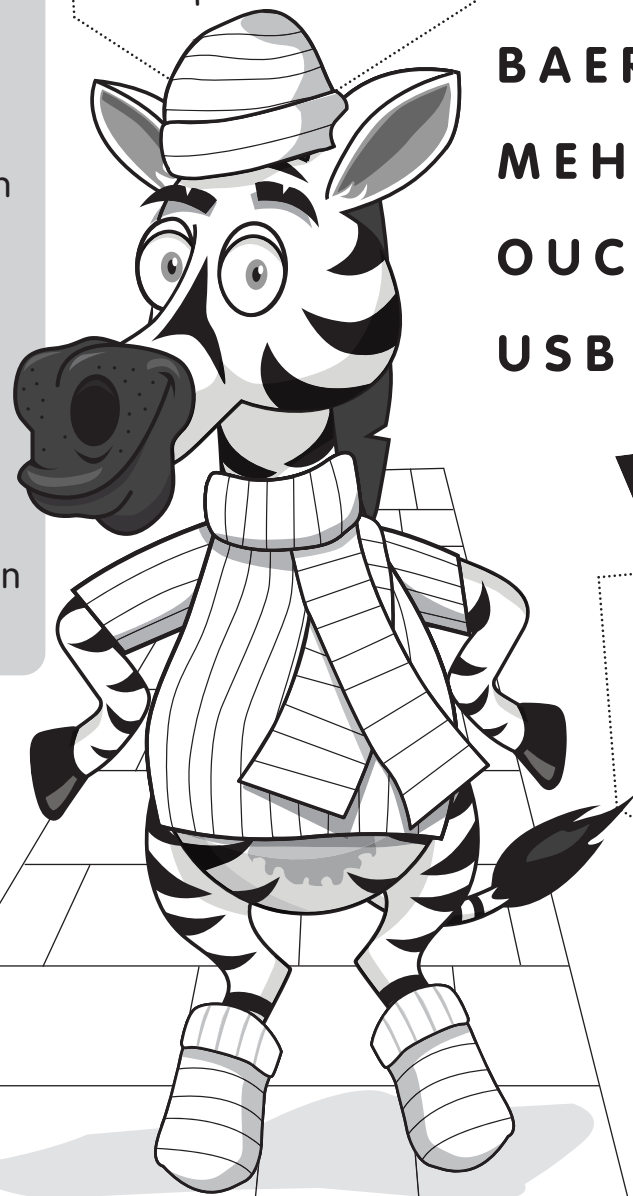

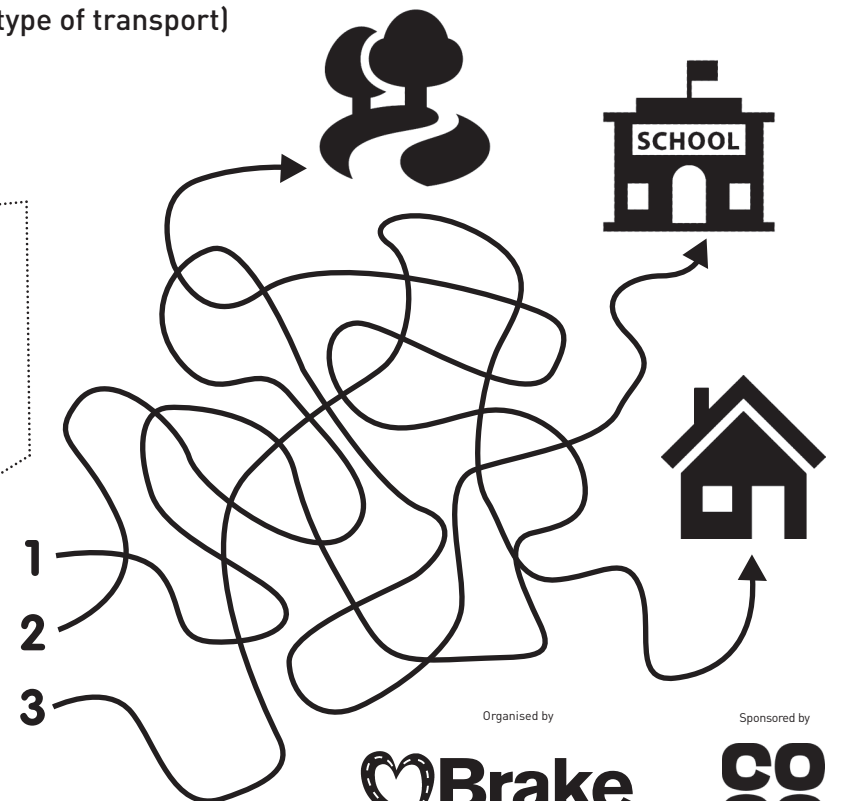
Show my stripes
